FAQ

What does the season look like?

The regular season runs from March 4 through the middle of June.

2/6 AAA, Majors, Junior starts practice

2/13 All other divisions practice starts

Mid June District 11 Tournament of Champions (TOC) for some teams in the AAA and above levels.

June/July All-Stars for selected players ages 8 and up begins with practices about mid-June.

Tournaments begin late-June and could take most the summer if the team wins and advances.

Cancelled games?

- If field conditions are damaged or unsafe, games may be cancelled by the league or City of Lincoln.
- We will do our best to reschedule games. Rescheduled games will take priority over practices.
- You will be notified by 3pm if fields are closed.
- No news is good news. If you do not hear from us, the decision is up to you.

SAFETY

- Safety Coordinator: James Walker
- The required annual Safety Course (SAFE Baseball/Coach Deck) will be emailed to you – please complete this ASAP.
- All injuries that occur on the baseball field must be reported within 24 hours and an <u>injury form</u> must be completed and emailed to the league safety officer at: <u>safety@lincolnllbaseball.org</u>. The injury form is located on the LLL website.

SAFESPORT ACT

- In 2018, the "Protecting Young Victims from Sexual Abuse and SafeSport Authorization Act of 2017" became Federal law.
- The mission of the U.S. Center for Safesport is to make the athlete well-being the centerpiece of our nation's sports culture.
- All athletes deserve to participate in sports free from bullying, hazing, sexual misconduct, or any form of emotional or physical abuse.
- Education and awareness are the most critical components to creating safe and respectful sporting environments, free of abuse and harassment.

SAFESPORT ACT

- There are certain requirements from the SafeSport Act that Little League International and all local little league programs must adhere to.
- Reporting of Sexual Abuse involving a minor to the proper authorities:
- All volunteers of a local league are now mandated reporters and could face criminal charges if the league chooses to ignore, or not report to the proper authorities, any witnessed act of child abuse, including sexual abuse, within 24 hours.
- Leagues must adopt a policy that limits one-one-one contact with minors
- Managers and coaches are highly encouraged to complete the below Abuse Awareness training provided by USA Baseball and SafeSport:

BACKGROUND CHECKS

- Little League International requires all leagues and districts in the United States to conduct background checks that utilize JDP Background Screening, or another provider that is comparable in accessing background check records for sex offender registry data and criminal records.
- Every volunteer in the league has to have a completed background check. This includes managers, asst. coaches, practice coaches, scorekeepers, team parents, etc.
- You are responsible to report all volunteers on your team to the league so that we can ensure that a background check has been completed. All volunteers must also enroll as a volunteer on the LLL website.
- You are required to notify us of ANY volunteers on your team so that we can run a background check.
- DOJ is requiring all volunteers to complete a Live Scan. The cost of the Live Scan is \$10 and emails have been sent to volunteers for dates LLL has coordinated locations with Roseville Notary and Live Scan Services ("RNLSS"). If these dates are missed the volunteer will need to schedule with RNLSS directly.

- Lower Division: One game per week, one practice per week until April 28th. Then two games per week until end of season.(Practice may still be scheduled one time per week depending on Manager and field availability.)

T-Ball: 1) batting tee, 1) bat, 3) batting helmets, 1) set of throw down bases, and 1 dozen soft/level 1 baseballs.

Farm/Single A/AA: 1) set of catchers gear, 1) bat, 3) batting helmets, and 1 dozen semi-soft/level 5 baseballs.



TEAM PARENT

Every team has a Manager (head coach), Coach (es) and a Team Parent.

Older divisions also need field prep and scorekeepers

The Team Parent is responsible for helping with league reminders, team communications, banners, photo day, snacks, team party, etc. Managers/Coaches have a lot on their plate. It's helpful for another person to manage this for the team.

Catcher

A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a game cannot play the position of catcher for the remainder of that day. If a catcher catches 4 innings or more, they cannot pitch in that game.

• Pitch Count:

The league age pitch counts for Little League Baseball® are as follows:

Ages 13-16 – 95 pitches per day

Ages 11-12 – 85 pitches per day

Ages 9-10 – 75 pitches per day


Ages 7-8 – 50 pitches per day


